BIOGRAPHY

Teemu Reiman has a doctoral degree in psychology from the University of Helsinki, and a title of Docent (Adjunct Professor) from the Aalto University. Reiman works as a senior scientist in the organizational psychology research group at VTT Technical Research Centre of Finland. Reiman's area of specialty is safety culture and safety management of complex sociotechnical systems. Reiman made his dissertation in 2007 on safety culture evaluations of nuclear power plant maintenance organizations. Reiman has acted as a project manager and a researcher in several national and international research and consultancy projects covering a wide range of topics from safety culture and management to resilience and properties of complex adaptive systems. Reiman has experience from various safety-critical domains including nuclear power, conventional power, transportation, metal industry, oil industry and healthcare. In addition to scientific publishing of more than 30 papers and articles, Reiman has written in Finnish two popular scientific books on human factors and safety critical organizations (published by Edita Publishing). Reiman also teaches safety management and leadership at the Aalto University.
